Located at historic Fair Park in Dallas, Texas Discovery Gardens is a 7.5 acre year-round organic urban oasis filled with natural wonders for visitors of all ages. Featuring native and adapted plants, children and parents can share the experience of being amazed and inspired by nature's intricate web of life.

Throughout the year enjoy family festivals, free admission days, and the extensive (and growing) EarthKeepers® student education program which introduces children and adults to natural outdoor learning experiences. Gardening workshops and guided tours provide expert advice on using native and adapted plants to create backyard habitats for butterflies, birds and other native wildlife.

Inside, the two-story Rosine Smith Sammons Butterfly House and Insectarium transports you to a tropical rainforest, complete with hundreds of free-flying butterflies.

June 1 - June 29

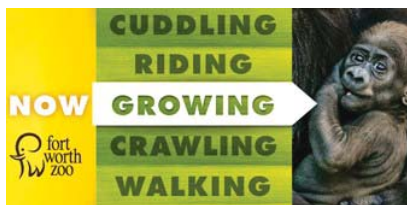
(Every Wednesday Night)

Six Flags Fiesta Texas

Prepare to experience the Fiesta Bay Boardwalk like you've never seen it before. Six Flags Fiesta Texas' Triple Threat of Thrills is now open.

Fireball featuring an astonishing 72-foot loop that delivers unanticipated weightlessness. On this new adventure, you'll sit face-to-face with other riders and rocket back and forth up each side of the loop, then flip completely upside down during a series of 360-degree inversions. At any surprising moment, your train will suddenly change directions and send you back around full-speed in reverse.



Another distinct offering in this new trio of thrills – **Hurricane Force 5** will rotate both clockwise and counter-clockwise with guests sitting on motorcycle-like seats facing outward. This giant 24-passenger hurricane-shaped disc will arc from side to side on an almost 5-story high half-pipe track while rotating at 14 revolutions per minute. This innovative attraction is a first-of-its-kind in the state.

A third new attraction, **Spinsanity**, will send riders spinning, twisting and rolling through a cycle of classic, thrilling fun. This modern adaptation of a traditional Tilt-A-Whirl will provide more panoramic, unobstructed views and is unveiled the same year as the 90th Anniversary of the original boardwalk favorite.

For a nominal fee, you may soar like an eagle from atop the quarry wall for a breathtaking bird's eye view directly over **SUPERMAN Krypton Coaster** and portions of Rockville (including the new **BATMAN: The Ride**), as you sail along effortlessly in special side-by-side seating. Once you are seated and secured on the ride, you will briskly travel forward-and-backward over 1,500 feet, and climb nearly 155 feet in the air, well above the park's distinctive quarry walls. Once at the top, the descent begins as you race back to earth with the wind in your hair flying over **SUPERMAN Krypton Coaster's** track a total of six times along your park-wide aerial journey. Picking up speed as you approach the loading station, you are safely decelerated and brought back once again to the ride station. Be sure to check out this new adrenaline rush! Designed for the entire family, the height requirement will be just 40". Buy your Zipline Pass online and pay just \$20.

Still to come this summer is a ground-breaking new ride experience – the **SUPERMAN Virtual Reality Coaster**. On one of North America's first dedicated Virtual Reality Roller Coasters, you'll experience thrills like never before. In partnership with Samsung Gear VR and Oculus, **SUPERMAN** will be equipped with wireless headsets that, while wearing, allow you enter a virtual world with high-resolution imagery and 360-degree views that synchronize to the action of the coaster.

Rockin' the River

Live on the Trinity River, June 16 - August 11 (Every Thursday Night)

It's a free weekly summer concert series with a cool twist, the stage is right on The Trinity River in the shadow of downtown Fort Worth. You can enjoy the show floating in the river or, if you're a landlubber, bring a chair or blanket and enjoy a great view from the shore. Top each night off with an awesome fireworks show and we'd call that near perfect! In bad weather, shows move indoors to The Shack—near the Panther Island Pavilion parking lot gate. Gates open at 4:30pm, Headliner plays 6:45-8:15pm (Coors Waterfront Stage), clear the water at 8:15pm, the After Party Band plays 8:30-9:30pm (Southshore Stage), Fireworks Show at 9:30pm.

Parking and admission are free but there is a VIP package available this year designed to make a splash with your group. The 2016 Rockin' the River Series 4-Pack Pass is a deal designed to allow you and three of your guests to experience a summer of shows in VIP style for the entire 10-show season. The number of passes sold will be limited, so split the cost with friends and get yours before they sell out.

Your furry friends are welcome but MUST be on a leash at all times and you must pick-up after them. Since there is a fireworks show, please consider the noise level before bringing your dog. You can bring your own self-inflated tube, raft, kayak or anything else that floats...just nothing with a motor! Otherwise, there will be tubes, kayaks, canoes, and stand up paddle boards for rent as well as awesome tees, coozies and dry pouches for sale too. Food from Salsa Limon and beverages will be available for purchase. Coolers will be provided if needed but must be returned at the end of the night. **NO OUTSIDE COOLERS, BEVERAGES OR FOOD** are allowed on site. Anyone breaking this rule will be asked to leave the event. This event includes loud music and alcohol so please use discretion when taking young children. Children less than 30" tall will not be allowed in the water. All children 12 and under must wear a life jacket while in the water which will be available on site, free of charge (generously provided by Tarrant Regional Water District and Cabela's).
