DART Connects You to Entertainment & Dining

With 90 miles of light rail and 62 stations, DART opens up a world of possibilities for North Texas families seeking fun staycation adventures.

The Dallas Arts District is the largest arts district in the nation, boasting three museums, several performance venues, and buildings by four Pritzker Prize-winning architects. The district is bordered by Klyde Warren Park, a deck park over Woodall Rodgers Freeway that connects downtown and Uptown Dallas. The popular spot has become Dallas' "front yard." It's all within blocks of the St. Paul and Pearl/Arts District stations, or right along the M-Line Trolley.

Consider exploring the Bishop Arts
District, located just outside of downtown,
which offers a unique blend of boutiques,
