## **Dallas Zoo**

Animal fans from around the world who watched online as a giraffe was born at the Dallas Zoo last month got to help choose her name. Zookeepers chose three possible names

to vote on, all with African themes. Adia means "a gift," Kanzi means "a treasure," and Kipenzi means "loved one."

Voting was free, but fans also had the chance to help rescue and support threatened wildlife in Africa, including giraffes. A generous friend of the Dallas Zoo agreed to match any donations made in the baby's honor, up to \$25,000.

Mom Katie delivered the calf, weighing 139 pounds and standing 5 feet, 10 inches tall, live on Animal Planet television and Animal Planet L!VE streaming. Viewers cheered Katie on as she pushed for nearly an hour to deliver the calf, and over the next hours as the wobbly little one tried to stand, took her first steps and began nursing.

Every dime raised from donations linked to the vote will go to conservation efforts. Although the Dallas Zoo is a non-profit zoological park itself, they plan to use 100% of the donations for conservation efforts around the globe. The zoo partners with many organizations to save animals from extinction, including the Cheetah Conservation Fund, the Giraffe Conservation Foundation, the Tarangire Elephant Project, and more.

The festival, one of the largest and most popular Renaissance festivals in the country, began in 1981 and is located at 2511 FM 66 (just off I-35E) in Waxahachie, 30 minutes south of Dallas/Fort Worth. The "village" of Scarborough is 35 acres set within a 167 acre site and offers one of the largest outdoor "juried" craft shows in the country.

This season features two operas at Bass Hall and one at a smaller space, and the 2016 season will follow the same format.



JFK, which has been in development for several years, is by David T. Little and Royce Vavrek, the composer and lyricist behind Dog Days, which is in the 2015 season,



running through May 2. JFK takes place on November 21, 1963, which President John F. Kennedy and first lady Jacqueline Kennedy spent at Fort Worth's Texas Hotel, before that fateful day in Dallas. However, the shape of the piece changed a great deal through the developmental process and the end result should be fascinating. The classic title of the 2016 season is Rossini's comedy The Barber of Seville. The third entry is in the smaller stage series, Opera Unbound, and it will be two new one-acts: Buried Alive and Embedded. Both operas are based on Edgar Allan Poe stories, A Premature Burial and the The Cask of Amontillado, respectively. JFK and The Barber of Seville will be presented in Bass Hall, and Buried Alive/Embedded will take place in the Scott Theatre at FW Community Arts Center.

The 2016 subscriptions are on sale now, single tickets go on sale to the general public August 1. You may contact your concierge to order single tickets to all performances at a 25% discount (excludes value seating). ## **Hurricane Harbor**

If you missed it, as part of its 30th Anniversary Celebration in 2013, Six Flags Hurricane Harbor became even bigger, better, and wetter with the debut of 2 new additions, the Typhoon Twister and Tsunami Surge!

On the Typhoon Twister, you and a friend are in for an adrenaline-packed ride down a tunnel and into a bowl-shaped slide. You'll spin around in the belly of the slide before being thrust into a corkscrew exit and right into a refreshing splash pool. If you're still friends after Typhoon Twister, then take your friend over to Tsunami Surge. Twist and turn down a 68-foot enclosed tunnel and build speed to take on a 40-foot wave slide on the other side. You'll experience zero-gravity as you surge to the top of the slide before gliding into the landing pool. While you're there don't forget to experience the thrill of the chase on Sea Wolf, the fastest and tallest water slide of its kind. Then check out MEGA WEDGIE (don't let the name scare you); this waterslide with a whimsical name gives thrill-seekers an exhilarating ride. After that, head over to Boogie Beach or the family-friendly Hook's Lagoon before floating your cares away along the Lazy River. You're sure to find what you're looking for at Hurricane Harbor when they kick off the season on May 9. Contact your concierge for discount tickets.

#### **Bahama Beach**

Cool Off and Have a Blast at the Same Time! Bahama Beach Waterpark is the perfect place to cool off this summer. Open Memorial



Day weekend through August 16. The park is closed many days throughout the season, CHECK website for calendar and hours of operation. Conveniently located only ten minutes south of downtown Dallas, you can get away from it all without ever leaving town. They have everything from 45 foot tall slides for the big kids and adults, to an interactive water playground with a 1,000 gallon dumping bucket for the little ones. ## **Hawaiian Falls**

#### NRH2O

Opening May 16, NRH2O Family Water Park is conveniently located between Dallas and Fort Worth (in North Richland Hills). Dedicated to providing a safe, clean and fun environment for guests of all ages, the park is specifically designed with families in mind. At 17 acres large, they offer plenty of attractions to entertain all ages, including the world's largest uphill water coaster, a 5-level interactive water playground and the world's first Viper (which opened in 2011).

The Viper, a \$1.7 million ride, is a 430-foot slide that's 43.2 feet high. The slide was the first major addition to the park since 2009. The Viper is a family oriented thrill ride. It takes four riders (instead of two) and you're all facing one another so you can see the excitement on faces while you're riding.
