Texas Civil War Museum

The largest collection of Civil War artifacts west of the Mississippi River are on display at the Texas Civil War Museum. The museum is a collaborative effort involving private collectors Ray and Judy Richey and The Texas Division United Daughters of the Confederacy.

The museum has more than 3,000 artifacts which will rotate on exhibit. Among the artifacts is a collection of more than 60 flags valued at approximately \$3 million. It is the largest collection of flags in the state of Texas. Most of the flags are from Texas units that fought for the Confederacy.

This is one of the largest private collections of Civil War artifacts in North America. It is an essential stop for anyone interested in learning more about this important part of Texas and United States history.

The museum is a non-profit entity that includes artifacts from what was the Texas Confederate Museum displayed in

Austin from 1904 to 1988. The collection is controlled by The Texas Division UDC. This joint venture between private collectors and a public trust is considered rare among museum collections in the United States.

Among the featured displays at the museum is a collection of Victorian era dresses. The museum has over 200 dresses and about three dozen will be displayed on a rotating basis.

Operating hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 9am to 5pm. Admission is **\$6** (AD), and **\$3** for students (ages 7-12). Children 6 years and under are free when accompanied by an adult. NRH2O

NRH2O is opening on May 14 and has added a \$1.7 million ride, The Viper, a 430-foot slide that's 43.2 feet high. Due to open sometime this month, the slide will be the first major addition to the park since 2009.

The Viper is a family-oriented thrill ride. It takes four riders (instead of two) and you're all facing one another so you can see the excitement on faces while you're riding. The Viper will be the first one in North America. Other Vipers are being built in China and Dubai.
