Summer Fun To Look Forward To! Drive-In Due To Open Along Trinity Uptown

By Memorial Day weekend, just as movie theaters nationwide are starting the summer blockbuster season, Coyote Theaters hopes that area film fans will be pulling into its three-screen urban drive-in at Trinity Uptown.

The theater expects to show first-run movies in digital format. Moviegoers will be able to watch from their cars, rent cabanas or set up chairs in a designated seating area under pavilions. The movie soundtrack will play through car radios. Each screen will have room for 250 to 500 cars, and admission will be about **\$6** to **\$8** a person.
