To claim your tickets:

On the day of travel, please present your confirmation letter and photo ID at the Will Call Booth located inside the event grounds. Tickets are non-refundable/non-exchangeable. Missed trains cannot be refunded or rebooked. All tickets must be claimed prior to 20 minutes before departure. Tickets not claimed 20 minutes prior to departure time will be forfeited. Additional tickets may be purchased online or at the onsite ticket booth depending on availability.

Parking information:

Parking is available at the corner of Dallas Road and Main Street. Free shuttles and parking are provided at (2) locations, the Grapevine Convention Center at 1201 S. Main St. and Grapevine Public Library at 1201 Municipal Way. Please plan appropriately to ensure your party will arrive in plenty of time prior to departure. Due to holiday shopping, Christmas Capital of Texas® events, as well as road construction and highway closures, you may encounter traffic delays. The DFW Connector project may impact travel on IH 635, SH 121 and SH 114. For an updated list of road closures, visit www.dfwconnector.com.

Please note regarding the train and seating:

All North Pole Express trains depart from and return to the Grapevine Depot. Trains are enclosed and heated and will run regardless of weather conditions. Seating is offered on a first come, first served basis. There is no reserved seating. There will be two (2) ticket holders per seat. Groups will need to board together. Late arrivals will be seated as space is available. Non-ticketed infants must be held in an adult's lap. For safety reasons, strollers, infant car seats and carriers are not allowed on the train. Stroller parking will be available at the Grapevine Depot.

For questions please call 817-410-3557. Business hours are Monday (closed); Tue-Fri (10am-5pm), and Sat-Sun (11am-5pm).

Sundance Valet

If you've been to Sundance Square any time since May of this year, you were probably aware of the shortage of parking due to the construction. Now Sundance is providing valet service, Monday through Friday from 10:30am to 4pm in an effort to increase visitation during the weekdays and ease the strain of hunting for parking spots.

This service is available at valet stands on the east and west ends of Main Street between 3rd and 4th Streets. The stands are marked with red umbrellas, and the workers wear shirts and hats bearing a Sundance Square logo. The service is free to visitors with a validated ticket from a Sundance Square shop or restaurant, or guests can pay \$10 for the valet service. Parking is still available in various parking garages around the square.
