
Dallas Mavericks

As a client of Concierge Connection, you have the opportunity to purchase discounted tickets for selected games without any processing fees! Discounted tickets are available in all three levels of the arena, and are as follows:

Upper Bowl Seats (300 level): \$14 (reg \$17) & \$29 (reg \$33) Platinum Club Seats (200 level): \$90 (reg \$99)

Lower Bowl Seats (100 level): \$76 (reg \$84)

The process is simple, the seats are great, and you can print out your tickets as you buy, so it's very convenient! Tickets are limited, and games will



sell out quickly so place your orders NOW to get the seats you want!

To view available games, contact your concierge to email you a link that you will keep on hand. Anytime you want to order you simply click on that link and enter the Special Offer Code: mavs31 to purchase your tickets! Make sure and bookmark the site and check back often, as games may be added throughout the season! Go early and get ready to be rowdy, proud and loud!

Directions to purchase tickets:

- 1. Click on the link your concierge sends you.
- 2. Select Game (click on "Find Tickets").
- Enter the Special Offer Code: mavs31.Do not enter email address here.
- Create new Group Account if you don't already have a "Corporate Concierge group ticket account" for the Dallas Mavericks.
- 5. Select the number of tickets you would like to purchase.
- 6. If you get the error message "You have reached your ticket limit for this event," it means that there are no tickets available in the price requested. Try another price or "best available."
- 7. Purchase and print tickets (No Fees).

Texas Rangers

Texas Rangers 2013 season is near! Discounted tickets range from \$8-\$39 off of the regular price and depend on your game date selection, seating preference, and availability. Opening Day is Friday, April 5. It is considered a premier game and we cannot order tickets. The only way to guarantee tickets to Opening Day is to purchase a season plan through the Rangers. We can make calls for you to obtain them through other sources but will they be sold at a premium price.

However, you may begin ordering tickets for other games. Contact your concierge for a calendar with pricing chart for this year as well as a parking map and schedule of promotional game dates.

There are three price-points: Mon/Tues games, Wed/Thurs games, and Marquee games. Gate prices and pricing for Premier games will be listed to the left of the price chart on all games (for comparison purposes) – these are not the prices you will have to pay UNLESS you want tickets in a seating area where the "Concierge Discount" is not offered. Our discounts will apply in the following seating areas: Lower Box, Corner Box, AYCE Upper Home Run Porch, Lower Reserved, Terrace Box, Upper Box, and Upper Reserved.

Important Notes:

- ▶ What used to be the Cuervo Club is now the Capital One Club. It is exclusive to season ticket holders in Home Plate, VIP and Premium Infield seating areas thru the 3rd inning. AFTER the 3rd inning it will open to fans with tickets in sec. 18-34 and sec. 217-235, like it used to be.
- Captain Cash is the same, offered in \$5 increments at a 10% discount (valid through Sept 29, 2013). This can be added on to any order and is good to use at most concession stands for food and alcohol, as well as **most** merchandise. It **CANNOT** be used for tickets, parking, or game-used merchandise.
- ▶ General Parking has gone up from \$12 to \$15. Valet Parking is \$40. Parking can be added to any order so you can pay in advance, though it is the same price as if you pay cash upon arrival.
- ► The Friday Night Fireworks special has been raised from \$10 to \$15 for Upper Reserved this year. That's the same price as the Concierge Discount in that area. There probably won't be any offers made to the general public that will be cheaper than the Concierge Discount, but if there are we will be notified and offered the cheaper option to pass along to you.

AND MOST IMPORTANTLY:

The Concierge Discount is meant to be a benefit for our customers and their families to enjoy baseball games at a discounted price. If you purchase tickets to a game, and for some reason cannot attend, our rep is very lenient and willing to work with you. You will have the option to trade the tickets for another game or, if necessary, refund the money altogether (as long as there is enough time for you to "return" the tickets first). What they **DO NOT** want to see is our customers purchasing tickets, and then turning around and re-selling them using StubHub or any other avenue in order to make a profit. The Rangers do have a way to track the re-sale of tickets in their ticket system and the Rangers do reserve the right to refuse or discontinue service if they feel that this Discount Program is being taken advantage of in any way. So, please help us keep this valuable benefit in place for those who depend on the savings in order to afford to take their families to the ballpark.

SeaWorld San Antonio marks the opening of its 25th operating season by offering guests more days to enjoy the park. This year, SeaWorld has 231 operating days on the calendar, making it the most days in a single year that the seasonal theme park has operated in more than two decades.

Spring at SeaWorld

SeaWorld's waterpark, Aquatica, ushered in spring when it opened on March 2, which was the earliest advertised 2013 opening of an outdoor waterpark in Texas. The new waterpark opened in May 2012 and features up-close animal experiences along with water rides from the serene to the extreme.

On Saturdays now through June 1, SeaWorld guests can enjoy extended hours for **Spring into Night**, featuring the park's hottest nighttime shows, including:

- Shamu Rocks!, a crowd rockin', electrifying show featuring SeaWorld's famous killer whale, Shamu.
- Sea Lions Tonite, showcasing pinnipedpranksters, Clyde and Seamore, as they spoof the park's daytime shows.
- Elmo Rocks, a Sesame Street rock 'n roll musical show starring Elmo with Zoe, Cookie Monster, Bert and Ernie.
- Sesame Street Bay of Play Block Party, where guests can dance and sing along with all their favorite Sesame Street friends.

SeaWorld's "Just for Kids" series takes place on weekends in April and features live children's shows by nationally-recognized entertainers on Saturdays, including Caillou, Laurie Berkner, Choo Choo Soul and Imagination Movers and the Sesame Street stage show "Elmo Rocks" on Sundays. On May 4, the park welcomes Dove-award winning and Grammy nominated Christian rock group MercyMe as they headline the park's Praise Wave event.

2013 General Admission

Gate prices are \$64.88 (AD) and \$56.23 (CH, 3-9) for one day. Contact your concierge to purchase discount tickets for \$55 (AD) and \$49.50 (CH, 3-9). All prices listed include tax. Our tickets are valid for 2 days and 2nd day must be used within 14 days of first visit. Admission tickets do not include Aquatica San Antonio. However, admission tickets can be upgraded at the park for \$25 + tax to include a visit to Aquatica.

NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT...

IMPORTANT INFORMATION for Buildings Without an On-Site Concierge Many of our buildings have utilized our services for several years. Since there are new tenants in most of those buildings, I'd like to cover a few important things regarding the services. The management company of your building has "contracted" us to offer you concierge services. They pay the monthly fee required so it is a "complimentary" service for you and is ONLY available to those who work in your building. Although we will cover some of the most important information when utilizing the service, you may log onto our website at www.cciservices.org to learn more about the company and what we offer.

- 1) The services are available (Mon-Fri), 9am-5pm (excluding holidays). There are a few times throughout the year when our team is required to attend meetings or report to one of our buildings for special events. Therefore, there could be short periods of time that we are not available. However, ALWAYS leave a message or send an email and we will get back to you ASAP!
- 2) We will deliver tickets to your building every Friday (no later than noon) and you must pick your order up no later than 4pm that same day. (However, be aware that most management offices close earlier the day before a holiday). We are not responsible for tickets that are not picked up on time.
- 3) Should you miss a weekly delivery (or not working on a Friday), you may go to any one of our on-site locations nearest you to get the tickets you need for the weekend. If you decide to exercise that option, we would be happy to give you that location and contact information, hours of operation, and payment options (as some do not accept credit cards). You must confirm with that on-site concierge an ETA prior to your visit so they can attempt to be at the desk when you arrive—saving you an extended wait—as well as verify ticket availability.
- 4) Each month (on or around the 1st), you should receive an emailed concierge newsletter with updated information from either the "management office" or the "tenant contact" for your particular company. If for some reason you do not receive a copy, log onto our website at www.cciservices.org and click on the "newsletter tab" at the top of the page. Scroll down to the hyperlink for the current month's issue.
- 5) That same "newsletter tab" on our site has a link for "Discount Tickets & Passes" (which is updated on the 1st of each month as well). You may view a list of the many discount tickets available to you by clicking on that link. The website is also a good source for information on additional services available to you.
