Sales Tax Holiday

August 9-11, 2013

Texas shoppers get a break from state and local sales taxes on August 9, 10 and 11 - the state's annual tax holiday. Layaway plans can be used again this year to take advantage of the sales tax holiday.

As in previous years, the law exempts most clothing and footwear priced under \$100 from sales and use taxes, which could save shoppers about \$8 on every \$100 they spend. Backpacks under \$100 and used by elementary and secondary students are also exempt. A backpack is a pack with straps one wears on the back. The exemption during the sales tax holiday includes backpacks with wheels, provided they can also be worn on the back like a traditional backpack, and messenger bags. The exemption does not include items that are reasonably defined as luggage, briefcases, athletic/duffle/gym bags, computer bags, purses or framed backpacks. Ten or fewer backpacks can be purchased tax-free at one time without providing an exemption certificate to the seller.

Clothing & Footwear

Baby clothes, belts with attached buckles, boots (cowboy, hiking), caps/hats (baseball, fishing, golf, knitted), coats and wraps, diapers (adult and baby), dresses, gloves, gym suits and uniforms, hooded shirts and sweatshirts, hosiery, jackets, jeans, jerseys (baseball and football), jogging apparel, neckwear and ties, pajamas, pants and trousers, raincoats and ponchos, robes, shirts, shoes (sandals, slippers, sneakers, tennis, walking), socks (including athletic), shorts, suits, slacks, and jackets, sweatshirts, sweat suits, sweaters, swimsuits, underclothes, work clothes and uniforms.

School Supplies

The 81st Texas Legislature passed HB 1801 (2009) expanding the list of items qualifying for exemption from Texas state and local sales and use taxes during the annual sales tax holiday in August. In addition to clothes, footwear and some backpacks, Texas families also get a sales tax break on most school supplies priced at less than \$100 purchased for use by a student in an elementary or secondary school.

Qualifying school supplies (if priced less than \$100): Binders, book bags, calculators, cellophane tape, blackboard chalk, compasses, composition books, crayons, erasers, folders (expandable, pocket, plastic, and manila), glue, paste and paste sticks, highlighters, index cards, index card boxes, legal pads, lunch boxes, markers, notebooks, paper (loose leaf ruled notebook paper, copy paper, graph paper, tracing paper, manila paper, colored paper, poster board, and construction paper), pencil boxes and other school supply boxes, pencil sharpeners, pencils, pens, protractors, rulers, scissors, and writing tablets.

Cut College Textbook Expenses

This textbook shopping program site can save students hundreds of dollars a year on the cost of books for college. Christian Genco paid about \$1,200 for college textbooks one semester and decided that was enough. The next semester, Genco decided to shop online and after a couple of days of searching, he found books for \$800-\$900. Genco liked the fact that the books were cheaper online. but was dismayed that it took two days to find the best deals. Genco, then a student at SMU, went to work. Using computer coding and information already available on the Internet, he created a program that automatically searched for the lowest priced textbooks he needed. After graduating in May, he continued to fine tune the program, which has evolved into a free service for college students called textbooksplease.com. Genco's website offers college students a chance to compare prices for textbooks with a series of computer clicks. The program pulls books from a variety of retailers or shopping sites such as amazon.com. Genco said he gets an "affiliate's fee" from retailers to help maintain the website. From the Star-Telegram

NewlyMaid accepts bridesmaids' dresses from ALL bridal industry brands including bridesmaid dresses, mother-of-the-bride, social occasion and even prom dresses. The dress should be in good condition, with zippers and clasps working and no stains, rips or pulls visible. It does not have to be dry-cleaned!

Step 3: Receive your new dress and mail back your

old one. Your new dress will come packaged with a prepaid shipping mailer so you do not have to pay shipping to send in your old dress. Place your old dress in it and send it back. Once NewlyMaid receives your old dress, it will be processed for donation to charity. NewlyMaid has partnered with Clothes4Souls, which will be the recipient of all garments in good wearable condition. Clothes4Souls brings shoes and apparel to people in need around the world. NewlyMaid is also currently working on a number of ways to recycle dresses by turning them into new filament for eco-friendly fabrics.
