### Bottomless mimosas and lobster sandwiches in the heart of downtown.

In 1913, F.W. Woolworth in downtown Dallas had all that and a bag of light bulbs. But this is 2014, and you're going to want to visit that old five-and-dime one again, this time for some unique snacks and cocktails. The almost-secret entrance to the new restaurant is off the Stone Place walkway. The upstairs spot seats 100 at window-side booths and tables draped with white linens. Exposed brick, hardwood floors, French-style windows, and a wood-paneled library with a couch and fireplace add old-school distinction. Go for the lobster sandwich (Maine lobster, Brie, sourdough bread) and wash it down with a Sweet Bombshell Blonde (lemon, St. Germaine, vodka, Bombshell Blonde beer). Or hit Sunday brunch for bottomless mimosas and bottomless sangria for only \$11. Try a Hangover (jumbo buttermilk biscuit topped with habanero fried chicken, maple syrup, fried eggs, ham, sausage, bacon, hash browns, and pepper gravy).
