The **Texas Sports Legends** exhibit will be featured in the Hall of State, while **Construction**®, benefiting the North Texas Food Bank and Tarrant County Food bank, will be highlighted in the Lagoon area of the



Fair. The new **Wild West Pet Palooza** show (created especially for the State Fair of Texas), will take place in the historic Fair Park Band Shell. One unique aspect of the show is that all of the featured animals have been rescued from shelters across the country. Joel Slaven and his staff of trainers have adopted hundreds of homeless pets and brought them back to star in shows all around the country, including Sea World®. These animals are given a second chance at life, with a happy home, plenty of play time and most importantly, lots of love and affection.

For generations, the State Fair of Texas has been the destination to bring all Texans together and celebrates our great state with amazing food, shopping, live music and family fun.
