

The Good Neighbor Parking Experience

If you are headed to the popular West 7th development off West Seventh Street, there is great news! The "Good Neighbor Parking Experience" has been rolled out just in time for the holiday rush.

All five garages now offer complimentary parking from 7am to 5pm. So long as you pull your ticket before 5pm, you keep your free parking rate, no matter when you leave.

Those who use the garage after 5pm get the grace period of 1 hour for free parking. Hit the 2-hour mark and you're looking at an affordable \$3. It's then \$6 for 2-3 hours, \$8 for 3-4 hours and a \$10 maximum for 4 hours or more. Make sure you have a credit card available, cash is not accepted.

A separate Molly the Trolley service, the Burnett Plaza Lunch Line, runs from 11am to 2pm weekdays from the west side of downtown to Sundance Square.

If you do not have the printable ticket, please have your ticket accessible from your smart phone. Present your ticket or smart phone to receive a boarding pass. All groups must be together prior to receiving boarding passes. Tickets are non-refundable/nonexchangeable. Missed trains cannot be refunded. Parking:

Free parking without shuttle provided is available at 815 S. Main St (corner of Main & Dallas Road) and 400 W. Dallas Rd (across the street from the police department). Free shuttles and parking are provided at Grapevine Public Library at 1201 Municipal Way. Please plan appropriately to ensure your party will arrive in plenty of time prior to departure. Due to holiday shopping, Christmas Capital of Texas events, as well as road construction and highway closures you may encounter traffic delays. The DFW Connector project may impact travel on IH 635, SH 121 and SH 114. For an updated list of road closures, visit **www.dfwconnector.com**.

Please note regarding the train and seating: All North Pole Express trains depart from and return to the Grapevine Depot. Trains are enclosed and heated and will run regardless of weather conditions. Seating is offered on a first come, first served basis. There is no reserved seating. There will be two (2) ticket holders per seat. Groups will need to board together. Late arrivals will be seated as space is available. Non-ticketed infants must be held in an adult's lap. For safety reasons, strollers, infant car seats and carriers are not allowed on the train. Stroller parking will be available at the Grapevine Depot.
