For 31 years, Dallas Blooms has been one of the largest, most spectacular sights to behold in the spring and this year is no different! Stroll along the winding pathways through Dallas Arboretum to witness nature at work. This year's theme is "Deep in the Heart of Texans." This year's Texassized extravaganza will feature more than 500,000 blooming spring bulbs along with themed topiaries, entertainment, food and other activities celebrating the iconography of our state that is recognizable world-wide.

Texas is known as the state that does it big: our horticultural department's enterprising work is made evident throughout the 66-acre property – from the ground-breaking research conducted in our trial gardens to the 3,000 azaleas blooming in April. 
