GrapeFest

GrapeFest Golf Classic

GrapeStomp

Winners will be awarded the coveted and sought-after "Purple Foot" award. GrapeStomp challenge entry fee is \$5 per person (Does not include festival admission). GrapeStomp sessions occur every half hour at the following times: Sept. 17 (4-7:30pm), Sept. 18 (2-7:30pm), Sept. 19 (2-7:30pm), Sept. 20 (12-2:30pm). Special GrapeStomp events include the Senior GrapeStomp at 10:30am on Friday, September 18 and the Mayoral GrapeStomp on Saturday, September 19 at 11am. Children ages 13 and under can stomp for free. The GrapeStomp stage is located in the shadow of Grapevine City Hall and close to the Champagne Terrace.

AMC Theatre Changes AMC Gold tickets will no longer be available

AMC Gold tickets will no longer be available for sale after we deplete our ticket stock. The next time we place an order it will have to be for the new AMC Green tickets (which will have more restrictions).

Things to know:

- AMC Gold is currently an unrestricted ticket (not valid on 3D or IMAX films).
- These will still
 be accepted as long as they are in
 circulation so even though AMC will not
 sell them anymore they are still going to
 be valid.
- Once we have to buy the AMC Green tickets they too will be valid on new releases (with a restriction on 3D and IMAX films)...however, they will have an additional restriction and no longer be valid on any Disney or Disney owned films!

Here are some of the current movies a green ticket would not be valid on per the AMC website:

Beginning August 1, 2015, the AMC Gold Ticket product will no longer be available for purchase and will be replaced with the NEW AMC Green Ticket. The AMC Green Ticket is valid for one admission to any movie except those distributed by The Walt Disney Company, including, but not limited to, Disney, Pixar, Marvel and Lucasfilm, Ltd. titles. These tickets EXCLUDE ALL Disney movies, including: ANT-MAN, BRIDGE OF SPIES, THE GOOD DINOSAUR, STAR WARS: THE FORCE AWAKENS. THE FINEST HOURS, ZOOTOPIA, THE JUNGLE BOOK, CAPTAIN AMERICA: CIVIL WAR, ALICE IN WONDERLAND: THROUGH THE LOOKING GLASS, and FINDING DORY.

And the best way to reach the excitement is a DART train or bus.

DART Fares and Passes

You can purchase DART transit passes from DART's free GoPass app. The DART GoPass app is available in the App Store and the Google Play store. On GoPass, you can buy and store your tickets on your phone, access travel tools and rider alerts, and look up events and offers. Learn more at DART.org/GoPass.

DART passes also can be purchased at any rail station from the ticket vending machines (TVMs), which take cash, debit cards and credit cards. When purchasing a pass on a bus, exact cash or change is required. Bus operators cannot provide change.
