Texas Rangers 2016 season is here! Discounted tickets range from **\$2-\$20 off of the regular price** and depend on your



game date selection, seating preference, and availability.

Opening Day is Monday, April 4. It is considered a premier game and we cannot order tickets. The only way to guarantee tickets to Opening Day is to purchase a season plan through the Rangers. We can make calls for you to obtain them through other sources but they will be sold at a premium price.

However, you may begin ordering tickets for other games now. Contact your concierge for a calendar with pricing chart for this year as well as a parking map and schedule of promotional game dates. There are three price-points this year: Rookie games, All Star games, and Hall of Fame games. Gate prices and the higher pricing for Premier games will be listed to the right of our price chart on all games (for comparison purposes) – these are not the prices you will have to pay UNLESS you want tickets in a seating area where the "Concierge Discount" is not offered.

Enjoy full combat armored jousts, Birds of Prey exhibitions, Renaissance entertainment on 21 stages, Mermaid Lagoon, Renaissance rides, games of skill, exquisite crafts, 200 shoppes, artisan demonstrations, 9 pubs and taverns, and food fit for a King.

The festival, one of the largest and most popular Renaissance festivals in the country, began in 1981 and is located at 2511 FM 66 (just off I-35E) in Waxahachie, 30 minutes south of Dallas/Fort Worth. The "village" of Scarborough is 35 acres set within a 167 acre site and offers one of the largest outdoor "juried" craft shows in the country.

AT&T Byron Nelson Championship

May 15-22

The AT&T Byron Nelson celebrates the life and legacy of Mr. Nelson, the tournament namesake and friend, who passed away in 2006, but has been a part of the tournament since it began in 1968. In 1945, Mr. Nelson accomplished an incredible winning streak that has not been challenged to this day and will likely stand forever. He finished that year with 18 victories, including 11 straight, and established a record for the lowest scoring average (68.33), which remained untouched for 55 years. During his relatively brief professional career, Mr. Nelson had 54 career victories, including the 1939 U.S. Open, the 1937 and 1942 Masters, and the 1940 and 1945 PGA Championships.

Your concierge is now taking orders for discounted tickets to the 2016 Byron Nelson Classic. Daily grounds tickets give patrons access to tournament grounds, Champion's way and the Pavilion. The tournament will once again be held at the Four Seasons Resort and Club in Las Colinas. **Tickets are \$35 (reg. \$45).** Admission is complimentary for children 13 years and younger.
