The Irving Music Factory, Las Colinas' super-venue and entertainment megamall opening this September, will be inaugurated in style with opening weekend performances by Dave Chappelle, Brad Paisley, and others. The rest of the early lineup includes big names in comedy—Jeff Foxworthy and Larry the Cable Guy on Sept. 3 and, in November, The Daily Show's Trevor Noah—and music: Goo Goo Dolls, Megadeth, and Matchbox Twenty are among the bands breaking in the complex's 8,000-seat amphitheater.

The Optimus Prime of performance venues, the 8,000-seat amphitheater is a "boutique open-air pavilion" that can also be a 4,000-seat "indoor theater experience," or a 2,500-seat "intimate theater setting," depending on circumstances and likely ticket sales. Elsewhere on the 250,000 square-foot Music Factory campus, you'll find an Alamo Drafthouse theater, dining (Gloria's and Kabuki Japanese are among the restaurants announced so far), and shopping.

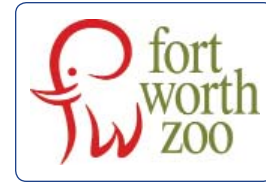

Wave Breaker:

The Rescue Coaster

The Wave Breaker: The Rescue Coaster is a one-of-a-kind thrill which launched June 16 at SeaWorld San Antonio. It combines the thrill of a roller coaster with the adrenaline rush of a marine animal rescue mission. Inspired by the heroics of the SeaWorld Rescue Team, Wave Breaker's jet-ski style car is the first of its kind in North America. The unique design engages riders in a straddled position and allows them to grip the handle bars as they race through a series of high-speed maneuvers and a pair of pulse-pounding launches over water.

Guests will board Wave Breaker: The Rescue Coaster in a queue-house themed with



stories from some of the 30,000 rescues the SeaWorld Rescue Team has been involved with over the past 50 years. Before launch, riders will be assigned a mission – a sea turtle, dolphin or sea lion rescue. After the mission briefing, riders will grip the handlebars and prepare to race into action covering 2,600-feet of track – the majority of which is located directly over water, creating the sensation that riders are racing across the park's lake. Each rescue mission will take a train of 16 riders through a more than three minute ride, reaching speeds of up to 44 mph and heights up to 61-feet. **Contact your concierge for discounts to SeaWorld.**

While communities across the United States celebrate Independence Day with fireworks, one of the country's most lauded and most unique celebrations is in Addison, Texas. At only 4.4 square miles, Addison is home to 16,000 residents and every July 3 a half-million guests from across the nation come to celebrate Addison Kaboom Town!

The celebration is city-wide, with a fantastic party in the 12-acre Addison Circle Park, watch parties at many of Addison's 180+ restaurants, 22 hotels and the incredible Addison Airport Air Show which can be seen from anywhere in town!
