## Tax Day 2017

You get three extra days to gather your paperwork and file your federal tax return in 2017. This year the tax deadline is April 18. Traditionally, April 15 is the last day you can file your annual return. However, this year April 15 falls on a Saturday, and while one might think Tax Day would be bumped to the following Monday, IRS agents will not be in the office on April 17 in observance of Emancipation Day, a holiday in Washington, D.C. that commemorates the day President Abraham Lincoln freed slaves.

All food and beverage service is by coupons, which can be purchased either online or at coupon booths located conveniently throughout the festival. Coupon booths accept cash, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. ATM machines are located conveniently throughout the festival. Coupons are non-refundable. Attendance is free!

## Frisco RoughRiders

Ever wanted to be called into Mr. Belding's office? Where do you stand on the Ginger-Mary Ann debate? Remember when the T-Birds and Pink Ladies ruled Rydell High? And do you recall when the best of reality TV was *The Newlywed Game*? If any of that rings a bell - or saves one - you'll want to be at Dr Pepper Ballpark this season. The Frisco RoughRiders, the Double-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, unveiled their theme night schedule for the 2017 season highlighted by Tribute to Grease Night, Retro Game Show Night, Tribute to Gilligan's Island Night, and 90's Nite.

**Tribute to Grease Night** races from Thunder Road to Dr Pepper Ballpark on Friday, April 21. Celebrate all things Sandy and Danny from the bonfire to the sock hop. And, yes, we haven't forgotten *Grease 2* with Stephanie Zinone and her cool riders. Don't be left stranded at the drive-in on this summer night.

**Retro Game Show Night** hits Dr Pepper Ballpark on Saturday, July 15, featuring an appearance by Mr. Game Show himself, **Bob Eubanks**, along with specially-themed jerseys. Eubanks rose to fame in the 1960s hosting *The Newlywed Game*, a landmark show that exposed the hush-hush of the freshly married.

**Tribute to Gilligan's Island Night** docks Friday, July 21 with **Dawn Wells**, the original Mary Ann Summers, aboard. *Gilligan's Island* ran from 1964-67 before living for eternity in reruns, with 2017 marking the 50th anniversary of the final episode. The first 1,500 fans will receive free Gilligan-style RoughRiders bucket hats.

Saved by the Bell principal Mr. Belding, aka **Dennis Haskins**, makes a special appearance for **90's Nite** on Saturday, August 19. On the quintessential high school show of the 1990s, Haskins did his best to keep Zack, Slater, Kelly, Jessie, Lisa Turtle and Screech in line. Mostly, he didn't. Get back to school with a special backpack giveaway for the first 1,000 kids in (perfect) attendance.

With each of these theme nights, fans have the opportunity to meet the celebrities as part of a free autograph

session during the game. The celebrities will also participate in promotional activities before and during that night's game. That's hardly all, as more than 30 theme nights are already planned. Other highlights include Bark in the Park Nights (Sun, April 23; Mon, June 19 and Wed, Aug. 30); Cinco de Mayo (May 5, Riders become Los Jinetes and mariachi bands perform); Take MEOW to the Ballgame (Sun, May 21); Strikeout Cancer Weekend (Fri-Sun, June 2-4); Faith Night with post-game concert (Sat, July 22); State Fair Night (Fri, Sept. 1); and College Night (Sat, Sept. 2).

There is no admission charge, however tickets are required for all food, drinks and children's activities. Ticket booths are strategically located and designated with large flags. Parking lots and garage structures in Southlake Town Square are free of charge.



**About the park:** Klyde Warren Park has become an oasis in the heart of Dallas, providing connectivity between Downtown and Uptown. This unique space is unlike any park in the region, offering over 1,300 free programs and events annually, including fitness classes, live music, children's activities, movie nights and holiday celebrations. In addition, the park provides table tennis, putting, foosball, badminton, a dog park, and a Reading and Games Room complete with a lending library. Their mission is to provide free programming and educational opportunities for the enrichment of visitors' lives, to showcase the multitude of cultures and talents Dallas has to offer, and to be a town square where citizens may congregate and create traditions.

**Operating the park:** Although the park is built, it costs roughly \$3.5 million to run the park each year, which the Woodall Rodgers Park Foundation raises through private donations, corporate sponsorships, event rental revenue, and contributions from a PID (public improvement district). Their public fundraising campaign, "I heart the park," celebrates how much we all enjoy Klyde Warren Park, as well as helps keep the park a safe and active jewel for our city. They are hoping to raise \$125,000 through online donations, social media awareness, and in events in the park, in support of Klyde Warren Park.

## D-Link to Deep Ellum

Deep Ellum is more DARTable than ever, thanks to new D-Link connections. The popular bus shuttle now stops at the corner of Elm Street and Good-Latimer Expressway, near the neighborhood's main drag, connecting it via D-Link to other popular neighborhoods downtown, like the West End, Farmers Market, Arts District and Uptown.



D-Link is free with about 15-minute frequencies and direct connections to other booming urban neighborhoods, making it a cinch to spend a day or evening exploring Dallas without having to park and move your car. D-Link runs from 10:30am until midnight, Monday through Saturday.

The shops, restaurants, galleries, clubs and murals of Deep Ellum are best experienced on foot. Step off the D-Link and into Dallas' funkier, most artsy district.

Hungry? **Stonedeck Pizza Pub** is serving classic, thin-crust pizza in a cozy environment steps from the D-Link stop. Over on Main Street, check out **B4**, Deep Ellum's own time machine to the '70s and '80s, crammed full of vintage toys and board games, vinyl records and old gaming systems. If it's from your childhood, B4 probably has it.

The neighborhood is rightfully famous for its nightlife. If you're looking for an old-fashioned Deep Ellum rock 'n' roll bar, **Three Links** is the real deal. 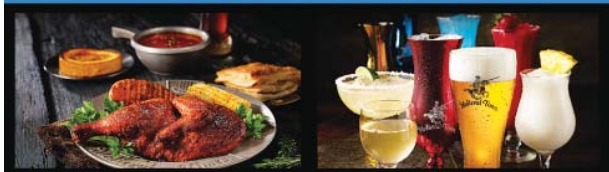
