## Frontier Forts Days

*May 12-13, 10am-5pm in Stockyard Station, Fort Worth, TX*

The 16th annual Texas Frontier Forts Muster, held at the Historic Stockyards in Fort Worth, Texas, will take place on Friday and Saturday, May 12-13, 2017. During this FREE, two-day heritage event, the Stockyards National Historic District is transformed into an authentic representation of Texas frontier life.

The Texas Forts Muster Celebration was created in 2001 to celebrate the heritage of Texas's Frontier fort settlements, like Fort Worth, concentrating on the years from the early Republic in 1836 to the closing of the frontier and settlement of the late 1800s. The camps, soldiers, Native Americans, settlers, and weaponry all reflect the region's vast expanses of open land, when most of Texas was unsettled and our big cities were generations in the future. Exchange Avenue in the Stockyards will be lined with encampments of historic fort sites from the Texas Forts Trail and elsewhere in Texas. Designed to highlight frontier-era life, Frontier Forts Muster brings together authentic wagons, flags, music, colorful uniforms and military gear from Texas landmarks. ## Wet 'n' Wild SplashTown

Wet 'n' Wild SplashTown is pleased to announce the addition of Alien Chaser, another new, one of a kind attraction for guests visiting the park this summer. The six-story tall two person slalom, drop and dive tube slide literally towers over the park at 60-feet high and draws attention from across the 80 acre park with its vibrant purple and black slides with alien themed saucers.
