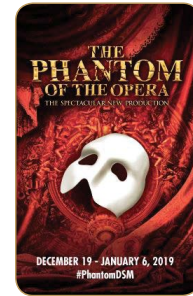

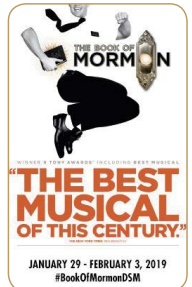

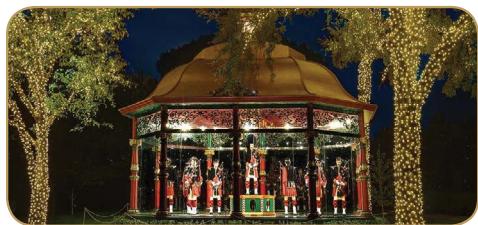

Holiday at the Arboretum

Through December 31

Holiday at the Arboretum features the return of the magnificent 12 Days of Christmas outdoor exhibit. The exhibition in the historic DeGolyer House returns with "The Artistry of the Nativity," with 500 crèches from over 50 countries representing so many cultures from around the world. In addition to the Ray Harrington and the Joe Christian collections, which the Arboretum owns, the private collections of Joyce and Larry Lacerte, Dan and Lydia Novakov, and a life-size crèche from Mary and Mike Terry, will also be on display. This is a unique opportunity to see these crèches as they have never been on public display before. Each of the 500 crèches are made out of unique materials including cork, Waterford crystal, horns, seeds, corn husk, glass, adobe, paper-mache, wood and coconut shells. In addition to the crèches, every room in the DeGolyer House will be elaborately decorated in holiday décor.



The garden re-opens for evening hours for The 12 Days of Christmas at Night exhibit, which is on display Wednesday through Sunday through December 30. With 500,000 lights illuminating throughout the garden, trimming the architecture of the historic homes and lighting the canopies overhead-including a 30-foot-tall tree at the center of property, this display is sure to warm the hearts of guests this season.
