New Vintage Wine and Gallery Trail & Blessing of the Vines

April 13, 10am-5pm, Historic Downtown Grapevine

Toast the good life at Grapevine's 27th Annual New Vintage Wine and Gallery Trail. Kick off the New Vintage Wine and Gallery Trail with the annual Blessing of the Vines, a centuries-old tradition performed by Christian priests all over the world. Some scholars say that the ceremony may be older than originally thought. Some ancient Roman texts show that a celebration centered around wine happened in April every year to ask the Roman gods for good weather and a bountiful growing season. At the conclusion of the blessing, enjoy a small sample of wine and some cheese before heading to your first stop on the trail. The first 150 attendees to the Blessing of the Vines will also get to take home a one year-old Texas champaigne grape vine courtesy of Womack Nursery to plant at home! (One per family). The ceremony will take place at the Town Square Gazebo located at 325 S. Main Street in Downtown Grapevine.

To begin the New Vintage Wine and Gallery Trail, you must pick up a passport to be used at the winery tasting rooms. Passports will be available for pick up beginning at 9am at the Town Square Gazebo, 325 S. Main St., Grapevine, TX. Participants must be age 21 or older. There is complimentary parking throughout Historic Downtown Grapevine as well as at the winery tasting rooms and art galleries. Special works of art can be viewed at Grapevine's Palace Arts Center in Historic Downtown Grapevine; the Grand Gallery and Tower Gallery at the Grapevine Convention & Visitors Bureau Headquarters; and at art galleries and fine art working studios throughout the city.

Admission for the New Vintage Wine and Gallery Trail is \$45 and includes a souvenir wine glass, three tastings of wine and one food item at each participating winery tasting room. The New Vintage Wine & Gallery Trail ends at 5pm. For more information, visit www.grapevinetexasusa.com.

AT&T Byron Nelson Championship

With a rich golf tradition in Dallas/Fort Worth, including a U.S. Open and two PGA Championships, the AT&T Byron Nelson has a long history in professional golf that traces its roots back to 1944. That year, Byron Nelson teed it up at Lakewood Country Club and won the Texas Victory Open by 10 strokes over his friend Harold "Jug" McSpaden. This annual tournament would continue for two more years—first as the Dallas Open and then as the Dallas Invitational. Nelson's victory at Lakewood Country Club was the beginning of two remarkable years in which he would win 26 tournaments, including his amazing streak of 11 straight victories in 1945.

The AT&T Byron Nelson is now the ninth longest-running active stop on the PGA TOUR schedule. The tournament has raised more than \$160 million over the past 51 years, making it the most financially successful charity event on the PGA TOUR. All proceeds from the tournament benefit Momentous Institute, the nonprofit operated by the Salesmanship Club since 1920. Momentous Institute directly serves over 5,500 children and family members each year through its nationally acclaimed Momentous School, innovative therapeutic services, and reaches thousands more through its research and training.

The Texas Rangers 2019 season has begun! There is so much to look forward to this season as the Rangers celebrate their final year at Globe Life Park in Arlington with 15 giveaways, pop culture theme nights and post-game concerts! Discounted tickets range from \$3-\$18 off of the regular price and depend on your game date selection, seating preference, and availability. This year, the discount will apply to all games except the last three home games of the season (September 27, 28 and 29). **Contact your concierge for a calendar with pricing chart for this year as well as a parking map and schedule of promotional game dates.** There are two price-points: All Star games and Hall of Fame games.



VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

A few years ago the Rangers implemented a dynamic price structure. The same remains true this year. This means there is a base price for every area, and then – based on supply and demand of any given game – the price of tickets could go up (if the demand is higher). They're still discounted from regular prices, and it is unlikely that the fluctuations will be too dramatic. They analyze their inventory for future games probably once a month and then make any changes they deem necessary. This also means that if you order tickets for a game one day, and then want to add tickets to that same game later, the price could theoretically be different at that time. You may purchase tickets in other seating areas besides those listed below but a discount would not apply.

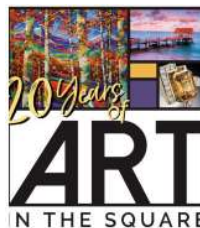
Dallas Zoo Welcomes Another Baby Gorilla!

Baby gorilla playdates will be endless this year at the Dallas Zoo as they welcome their second baby gorilla born in 21 years – and the second born in just the last year.



13-year-old critically endangered western lowland gorilla Megan quietly delivered the infant in the early morning on Thursday, March 7. This is Megan's first time raising a baby and both are doing well; Megan has been very attentive, and the baby is nursing often and is keeping a strong grip on mom. This birth brings another new wave of excitement for the Dallas Zoo – this is the first time they've cared for two baby gorillas at the same time in almost 50 years. Nearly nine-month-old gorilla Saambili (born June 25, 2018 to mom Hope) now has a half-sibling playmate, and she's already shown much interest in the newest addition.

The Dallas Zoo cares for ten gorillas, including the bachelor troop who live on the south side of the Gorilla Trail, and the family troop who live on the north side. All six family troop members have remained behind the scenes so Megan and her baby can bond privately. Zoologists will take their cues from Megan on her comfort level and readiness to explore the habitat. DART Rail Track Work Began March 30

DART Rail in downtown Dallas will be discontinued each weekend, for roughly six months, to allow track replacement between Pearl/Arts District Station and West End Station. Normal service resumes each weekday. Rail replacement and track improvements will create a smoother ride, eliminate ongoing maintenance issues, and increase the number of areas where trains can switch tracks, which will reduce service disruptions.

DART shuttle buses will connect the affected stations during track replacement. Two routes will stop at every Central Business District station. Three express routes will connect Pearl/Arts District Station, Union Station and Victory Station. Shuttle buses will load and unload at the red "Rail Disruption" bus stop located near each station. Signs on the rail platform will point you to these bus stops. Plan ahead and learn more at DART.org/plus.
