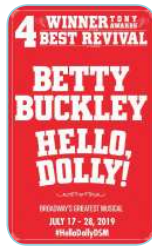

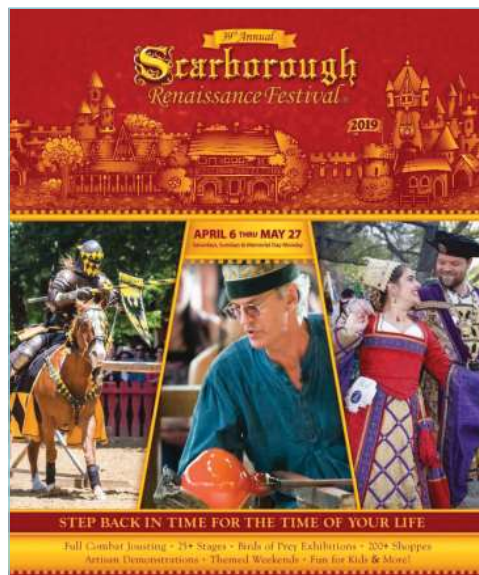

## Stingray Cove at Fort Worth Zoo

What has a tail... and wings... but swims underwater? The newest residents at the Fort Worth Zoo, that's what! Tucked just off the main path, beyond the Museum of Living Art (MOLA) and over the bridge, Stingray Cove is an all-new, interactive exhibit where guests can get up close to and touch a variety of stingrays and small sharks as they swim through the shallow saltwater pool. The pool is just the right height so that even the littlest visitors can see into the water. As you peer just over the pool's edge, you'll see more than 50 stingrays and sharks gliding through the water or nestling into the sandy bottom beneath you.
