The 2020 Cowtown

February 28-March 1

2020 Cliburn Festival: Beethoven at 250

The Cliburn joins a worldwide celebration of the 250th birthday of one of the world's greatest composers: Beethoven. He is revered as a musical revolutionary—having propelled music and its capabilities into the modern era—and also beloved for his profound connection to the joys, griefs, and hopefulness of humanity.

Cliburn Festival artists-in-residence will come together to explore his remarkable oeuvre of solo, chamber, and vocal works in five concerts over four days. It will be a showcase of the genius and spirit of Beethoven. The Festival features pianists Kenny Broberg (2017 Cliburn silver medalist), Sean Chen (2013 Cliburn third-prize winner), and Filippo Gorini (2015 Telekom-Beethoven first-prize winner); and the Verona Quartet. 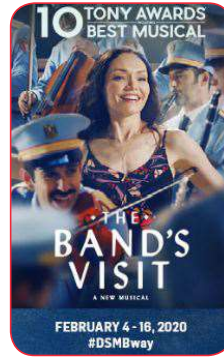

February 4-16 at Winspear Opera House

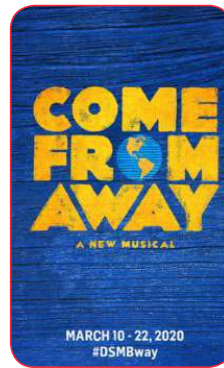

Museum of Nature and Science

While getting fit, eating healthier and conquering clutter are atop many New Year's resolution lists, the Perot Museum of Nature and Science is challenging North Texans to exercise their brains and get more science in 2020. And with 180,000 square feet of fun-filled STEM-based learning adventures, this Dallas hotspot is like a mega-sized cerebral gym complete with hundreds of amaze-your-brain experiences for adults and kids. The Perot Museum has something for everyone - from real ancient human relative fossils (that the Smithsonian and National Geographic recently named as top discoveries of the decade!) to a stunning Chinese minerals exhibit (showcasing more than 70 minerals). Other highlights include adults-only nights, sleepovers and new 3D films that take viewers to majestic faraway islands and through extreme weather.

The Museum's world-exclusive *Origins: Fossils from the Cradle of Humankind* exhibition invites visitors to meet their ancient human relatives – Australopithecus sediba and Homo naledi – marking the first time that hominin fossils of two different species have ever been displayed together outside of Africa.

WORLD EXCLUSIVE EXHIBITION! ORIGINS: FOSSILS FROM THE CRADLE OF HUMANKIND (through March 22). Presented in English and Spanish, the 5,000-square-foot exhibition tells the stories of two amazing human ancestor discoveries: from a young boy's stumbling upon the first specimen of Au. sediba, to the breathtaking journey of six female scientists – dubbed the “underground astronauts” – who excavated the bones of H. naledi from a deep and dangerously narrow cave complex in South Africa. Guests come face-to-face with the real fossils – some as old as 1.97 million years – and even observe scientists from around the country “in action” as they study the fossils in a glass-encased visiting scholars' lab. A 7-inch “squeeze challenge” lets visitors step into the shoes of scientists who physically navigated the tiny spaces to excavate the bones of H. naledi found underground. In addition, a backyard-sized dig site – surrounded by African taxidermy animals – lets visitors of all ages get their hands dirty using simulated ground-penetrating technology that scientists rely upon for fossil exploration.

The Perot Museum is partnering with the University of the Witwatersrand, the custodian of the fossils, and the National Geographic Society to showcase these specimens that are traveling outside South Africa for display for the first (and likely only) time. A surcharge is required for members and non-members.

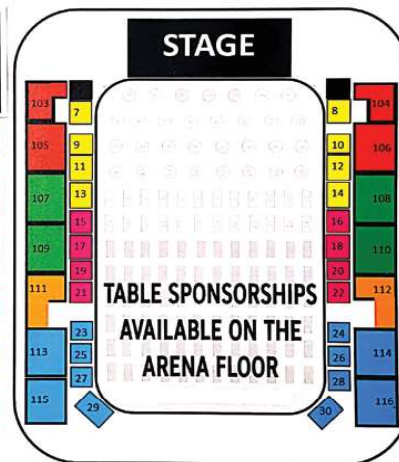
