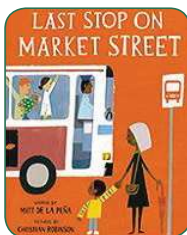

Texas Rangers

Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas

The Texas Rangers 2020 season is almost here! Exciting changes are under way as the Rangers move out of Globe Life Park and into Globe Life Field, which is scheduled to open on March 23. Our discount varies and will depend on your game date selection, seating preference, and availability. This year, the discount will apply to all games except Opening Day. **Contact your concierge for a calendar with pricing chart for this year as well as a parking map and schedule of promotional game dates.** There are three price-points: Rookie, All Star, and Hall of Fame games.

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION: A few years ago the Rangers implemented a dynamic price structure. The same remains true this year. This means there is a base price for every area, and then – based on supply and demand of any given game – the price of tickets could go up (if the demand is higher). They're still discounted from regular prices, and it is unlikely that the fluctuations will be too dramatic. They analyze their inventory for future games approximately once a month and then make any changes they deem necessary. This also means that if you order tickets for a game one day, and then want to add tickets to that same game later, the price could theoretically be different at that time. You may purchase tickets in other seating areas besides those listed below but a discount would not apply.

Our discounts will apply in the following seating areas: Infield Mezzanine (Sec 107-110, 118-121), All You Can Eat (Sec 233-237), Mezzanine (104-106, 122-124), Corner Mezzanine (101-103, 125-127), Left Field Reserved (Sec 27-33), Outfield Mezzanine (Sec 128-133, 136-142), Baseline Pavilion (Sec 208-213, 221-228), Corner Pavilion (Sec 205-207, 229-232), Outfield Pavilion (Sec 238-244), Upper Box (Sec 308-317) and Upper Reserved (Sec 301-307, 318-324).
