Learn about Grapevine and the city's heritage by visiting Nash Farm. Purchased by Thomas Jefferson Nash in 1859, this historic landmark brings history to life through exhibits, interpretive programs and touchable displays.

The farm grounds are open for self-guided tours during regular business



hours, admission free. The historic structures and exhibits are open during special events or during a scheduled tour and participation fees may apply. Help Nash Farm preserve, protect and visually reflect the agricultural heritage of the Grapevine Prairie by following their Usage Policy at www.grapevinetexasusa.com/nash-farm.

Events and activities throughout the year include First Fridays at the Farm, Spring into Nash, Fall Round-Up, Dairy Day, Victorian Christmas and many more. Attend one of their events or programs and spend your time touring the buildings, experiencing farm life, learning about farming and doing hands-on activities.

Group tours are available of the 5.2-acre farm, which centers around the Farmhouse Thomas built in 1869, the Historic Barn and a historic cemetery. Groups will be guided through each of these areas and have an opportunity to participate in seasonal hands-on activities presented by Nash Farm staff and volunteers. Pack a picnic and take advantage of their Pole Barn Pavilion following your tour.

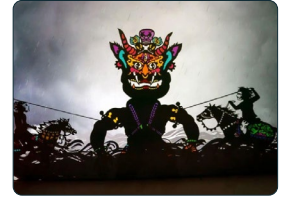

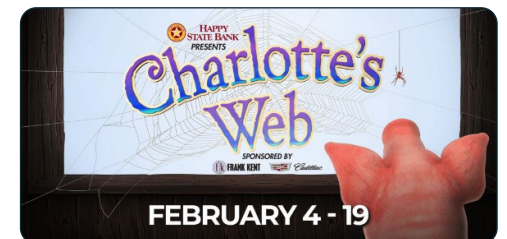
Hamid Rahmanian's Song of the North

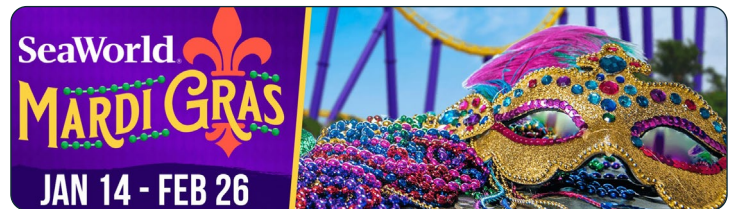
