St. Patrick's Day Parade & Festival March 14 | 9am-3pm Dallas, TX

Get ready for the 2026 Dallas St. Patrick's Day Parade & Festival, an event bursting with excitement, color, and community spirit on Greenville Avenue. Butterflies in the Garden Fort Worth, TX



Each spring, the tropical splendor of Fort Worth Botanic Garden becomes even more magical as the annual "Butterflies in the Garden" exhibit welcomes visitors into a stunning world of color and motion. From March 1 through April 30, 2026, the Garden's Rainforest Conservatory will be transformed into a lush tropical habitat where hundreds of live butterflies from across the globe flutter freely amid vibrant tropical plants and flowers, offering a rare opportunity for families, nature lovers, and photographers to experience these delicate creatures up close.

As you walk through the tropical display, you'll be surrounded by brilliantly colored species - from exotic visitors native to Central and South America, Africa, and Asia to local favorites that call Texas home. Among the crowd-pleasers is the iridescent Blue Morpho, known for its striking electric blue wings that shimmer in the conservatory light, enchanting guests of all ages.

Exhibit Etiquette

- Refrain from touching the butterflies, as it shortens their lifespan
- Butterflies and plants must not be removed from the exhibit, as per USDA permit regulations
- Food, beverages (including water), and large coats are not permitted inside the Conservatory
- Strollers are not allowed; however, wheelchairs and walkers are permitted. A self-check-in location is available for strollers
- Tripods and monopods are not allowed in the Conservatory

Texas Rangers 2026 season is near!

Opening Day is Friday, April 3. It is considered a premier game and we cannot order tickets. The only way to guarantee tickets to Opening Day is to purchase a season plan through the Rangers. We can make calls to obtain them through other sources but they will be sold at a premium price.

However, you may begin ordering tickets for other games beginning the first week in March. The Texas Rangers have a dynamic pricing structure. This means there is a base price for every seating area, and then based on supply and demand of any given game the price of tickets could go up (if the demand is higher). This also means that if you order tickets for a game one day and then want to add tickets to that same game at a later date, the price could theoretically be different at that time. **Contact your concierge for a full schedule, seating map, discount link, and promo code!**
